1. Call to Order

5. Treasurer Report

Treasurer Jamie Hedstrom provided an overview of the financial outlook as of December 31, 2025.

The financials as of December 31, 2025 currently present a net budget surplus of approximately \$1.7M, after accounting for budget encumbrances (estimated at this time) and funds allocated to 2026 purchases.

The largest surplus balances for 2025 are attributed to 9060.81 Hospital (\$652K), 3090.2 Certiorari (\$164K), 3416.1 Terminal Leave (\$188K), and 3413.4 Overtime-Firefighters (\$186K). The largest surplus in the Hospital GL account was anticipated, as the rates were released after our 2025 budget season and remained flat, while we had anticipated a double-digit increase based on historical experience. None of these accounts were increased in the 2026 budget and should be more closely aligned with 2026 expenditures.

Our Treasury Direct earnings in 2025, which were not budgeted for as they are not estimable, were approximately \$380K and further contributed to the surplus. In our 2026 budget, we estimated interest earnings of \$60K to account for normal interest earned on our JP Morgan accounts.

Additional 2025 invoices have not yet been processed which will impact the final 2025 surplus. After these invoices are processed, I will recommend year-end 2025 budget transfers for those accounts that have exceeded the amount budgeted.

The original agreed-upon cost of the engine was \$1,064,000; however, this amount is anticipated to decrease due to a change in the build. Any additional amount due in excess of the \$1,000,000 above will be paid with uncommitted surplus funds in 2026.

Other:

Treasury Direct Investments

We currently have \$6M invested in Treasury Direct Investments, in \$3M increments. Interest rates are currently around 3.5%. We will continue to decrease our investments to cover operating expenses through our next tax collection in May 2026.

Year End Filings

We will be issuing 1099's to our vendors and other payees where required and W-2's and 1095-C's to our employees by the end of this month.

Property & Casualty Insurance Renewal

We will be working with our broker, Arthur J. Gallagher & Company, on our upcoming P&C insurance renewal, which has a renewal date of 4/1/26.

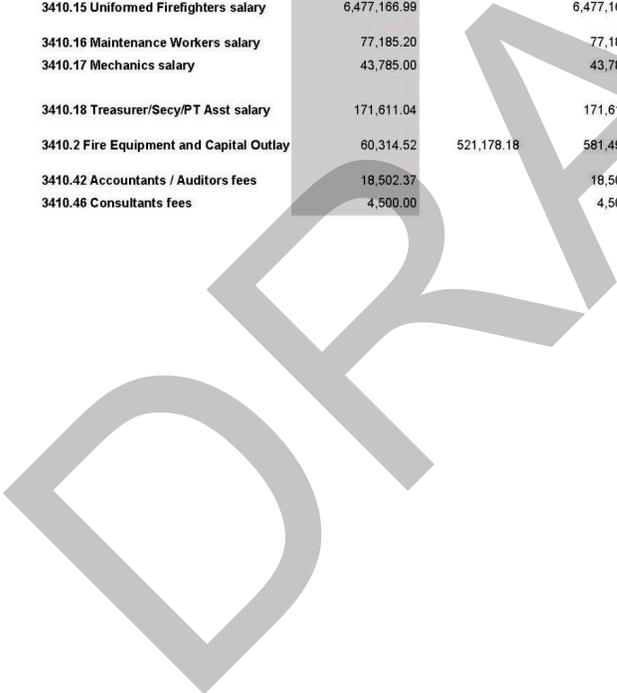

- On Sunday December 7th at 9:58 pm a report of fire at the Rivermere Apartments, 610 Lake Avenue Bronxville, was received. Captain Debitetto and the members of Group 4 responded and found a heavy fire condition in a second-floor apartment with reports of numerous people trapped on

multiple floors. Captain Debitetto quickly transmitted a 2nd alarm which brought Yonkers FD and FDMV to the scene and Scarsdale FD and Pelham Manor FD to cover calls at Fire Headquarters. The members made several rescues and used multiple hose lines to extinguish the fire. Many off-duty Eastchester FD members were recalled and came in to assist with the fire. Unfortunately, one resident could not be saved and passed away. I would ask the Board to hold an award ceremony at the April or May Board meeting to recognize the members efforts during the past year.

- The three probationary firefighters in the Career Fire Academy will graduate on Friday January 30, 2026 at the Chappaqua Performing Arts Center. They will then work 1-2 weeks of orientation in Eastchester before being assigned to their respective Group working the 24-hour schedule.
- Hank Henninger's mechanic report for December was emailed to the Board on 1/14/2026.
- Tim Dalton's maintenance report for December was emailed to the Board on 1/14/2026.
- Fire Prevention and Code Enforcement activities continue with numerous plan reviews and inspections. The Fire Prevention reports for December were emailed to the Board on 1/12/2026. Last night, Captain Pintavalle and Chief Tween met with the residents of The Rivermere for a Fire Safety Presentation.
- Currently there are two members are out on long term absence.
- The new Pierce Enforcer E-29 will begin construction on 5/7/26 with a delivery date in June of 2026. A month or two will be needed for radio installation and tool mounting and operator training. Hopefully it will go in service sometime in August.
- Highland Associates conducted a building conditions survey of the Bronxville firehouse. Commissioner Lore, Commissioner Ranellone, and Assistant Chief Yozzo attended the survey and reported it was very thorough.
- FEMA's Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) application period is expected to be open from 1/30/26 – 3/13/2026. The District previously received this grant when SCBA's were purchased approximately 14 years ago. I request the Board's authorization for myself and Chief Yozzo to submit the necessary paperwork and information to purchase replacement SCBA's and air pack bottles for the District. Should we receive the grant, it could save the District's residents more than \$600,000.00.
- As the cold weather is upon us, I remind residents to never use a power strip for a space heater as it cannot handle the higher amperage used by the heater and to please keep a safe clearance around space heaters.

Mr. Rooney asked Chief Tween if the report was posted on the website, and Secretary Isang affirmed it is. Mr. Rooney congratulated the hiring of a probationary firefighter and asked if that individual was replacing a retiree. Chief Tween confirmed that the individual is.

Commissioner Comments

Commr. Cerasi read a statement: This past Monday, January 12, I was notified of a motor vehicle accident that occurred on Scarsdale Avenue and Lee Avenue that involved a family member of mine, that happened to be my sister in law. Not knowing what had happened when I arrived at the scene, she apparently had hit a parked car that caused her vehicle to roll over onto the drivers side. I was unable to see the extent of her injuries as EPD was moving people back to avoid being hit by debris. I was finally able to observe from the sidewalk and record the Eastchester Firefighters use the jaws of life to extract her from the vehicle. All Firefighters did such a professional job getting her out of the vehicle, making sure she was comfortable, and moving her quickly in case of any serious injuries. I want to commend all Eastchester Firefighter personnel involved in this accident, and showed me that all the training that these men and women go through proves itself when the actual incident occurs. I would also like to note that no one at this time was aware of my presence or that this person was a relative. It wasn't until she was placed into the ambulance and taken to Westchester Medical that Eastchester Fire Personnel knew my involvement. From myself and my family, I want to thank these men for a professional and caring job, and in my opinion, EFD is the best. And all first responders out there, please stay safe.

Chief Tween asked the Board if they wished to have a Promotional and Award Ceremony. Discussion continued around the preparations. Chairman Lore recommended the month of May. The Board agreed.
