MOTION by Commr. Carlo and unan. carried to open the meeting at 7:00 p.m. to the public, followed by a salute to the flag.

Discussion took place between Commissioners, Chief Tween, and public member Mr. David Weir of the Bronxville Cemetery. Mr. Weir had hand-delivered a letter to Chief Tween a day prior regarding the stone retaining wall that is on the Bronxville firehouse property. Mr. Weir requested to be allowed to repair a section of the stone wall that adjoins the Bronxville firehouse and offered to repair the wall at the expense of his Cemetery. Mr. Weir asked permission to allow the workers access to both sides of the wall and provided the Board with an insurance rider.

Chief Tween shared that in 2018, the District had a survey done of the lot line and the cost was shared between both parties. The survey showed the wall is on EFD property. Chief Tween reported that part of the damage to the wall was caused by the Cemetery's snow plow company and ice melt used in their driveway. Mr. Weir shared that the Cemetery is repaving the driveway to the Cemetery and that is why the wall must first be fixed.

MOTION by Commr. Carlo and unan. carried to allow Mr. Weir to repair a section of the stone wall that adjoins the Bronxville firehouse at the expense of the Cemetery.
